Since then, he has been involved in the management of several accidents in France, such as the spill from the refinery of Donges in 2008 or the TK Bremen grounding in 2011, and participated in observation missions abroad in particular on the Deepwater Horizon rig accident in 2010.

He also chaired sessions and gave several lectures related to accidental water pollution issues in various national and international conferences.
