Olaf Trieschmann, Head of Section – European Maritime Safety Agency

Dr. Olaf Trieschmann is presently at the European Maritime Safety Agency, where he is heading the CleanSeaSet service. He is a senior expert on remote sensing and oil spill detection, was founding chairman of EGEMP (European Group of Experts on Satellite Monitoring of Sea-based Oil Pollution), member of the German delegation to the international GEO/GEOSS (Global Earth Observation System of Systems) initiative and member of the GMES (Global Monitoring of the Environment and Security) “Marine Core Service Implementation Group”. Mr. Trieschmann received his diploma and PhD in Physics from the University Karlsruhe, Germany. He started his professional career in remote sensing of the upper atmosphere in the framework of the ozone hole and global warming research activities. Since 2000 he is working on earth observation systems and in particular on oil spill detection technologies
