- NEED FOR CONSISTENT AND PRE-DEFINED ENVIRONMENTAL ADVICE AT ALL STAGES
- POOR RECORD KEEPING DURING SPILLS - LITTLE EVIDENCE OF CHANGE SINCE **AMOCO CADIZ**. FUNDING FOR WILDLIFE WORK IS A PROBLEM
- LITTLE EVIDENCE THAT CLEANED BIRDS SURVIVE
- IMPORTANT VETERINARY DATA FOR EUROPEAN BIRD SPECIES HAS COME FROM **ERIKA** STUDIES. GUIDELINES AVAILABLE 2002
- INTERNATIONAL COORDINATION OF BIRD DATA DOES TAKE PLACE
